The 2014 vintage has been good for whites. The cooler, wetter conditions aided the retention of freshness. Slightly lighter, livelier wines can be expected and we are excited to have a year like 2014 to kick off our new look.

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2014 Whites

Our first new vintage release will be the "Down to Earth" White, a Sauvignon Blanc & Semillon blend. This range has always communicated our philosophy of over delivering and the label is not changing. The wine has been doing well and the 2014 version will not disappoint.

Our 2014 Sauvignon Blanc and Bush Vine Sauvignon Blanc are also being released. They are both expressive of the variety, with the Bush Vine Sauvignon Blanc being particularly expressive of its terroir.

Our new fragrant white blend named "Jasmine" will also be released shortly.

It is a sweeter option designed to quaff on its own or to drink with spicier food. The 2014 Chenin Blanc and Barrel fermented Chenin Blanc will follow on in

the 2nd half of the year. They are richer wines with some oak involvement

and they are particularly attractive this year.

Our reds will only begin to appear with the new labels next year. In a massive boost to our reputation of over delivering on price, our 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon was rated by the Best Value Guru as being worth 3 times its price.
